

Instructions for recycling collection

Paper, cardboard and cardboard <u>can live almost indefinitely</u>. Just separate them carefully, at home, at school and at work, and don't throw them in with the trash.

In any case, remember to:

- do not leave paper, cardboard and cardboard outside the designated collection containers
- properly sorting paper, cardboard, and cardboard, e.g., removing adhesive tapes, staples, plastic bags, and other non-cellulosic materials, so that they are ready to be recycled
- Submit folded cardboard free of non-cellulosic packaging material such as Styrofoam and wood

Finally, he reminds that non-paper material mistakenly conferred with paper, in addition to becoming a waste to be disposed of, when made up of other recyclable material (e.g., plastic, glass, aluminum, wood, etc.) is diverted from other supply chains for which it represents an important resource.
